Graduation from High School or completion of a GED is required.

Licenses and Certificates:

Possession of a valid Pennsylvania State Driver's License is required.

Primary Functions and Job Details

The work of the sworn police officer involves responsibility for the protection of life and property, prevention of crime, apprehension of criminals and the general enforcement of state and local laws (ordinances). Duties normally consist of routine patrol, preliminary investigation and traffic regulation. Police officers also may be assigned duties as detectives, school resource officers, crime prevention officers, department training officers, task force officers, evidence technicians, field training officers, accident investigators, horse mounted officers, firearms instructors, TEAM officers, hostage negotiators, K-9 officers or special response team officers. Work involves an element of personal danger. The employee must be able to exercise sound independent judgment under stress. Assignments may include work on special tasks, which call upon specialized abilities and knowledge possessed by the officer. Work assignments can be general or specific and instructions are received from a supervisor who reviews work methods and results through reports, personal inspection and discussion. Finally, sworn police officers work under the agency chain of command structure.

MUHLENBERG TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Muhlenberg Police Department is seeking applicants to join our dynamic and dedicated police force. The Township is intending to hire Individuals who have the drive to excel and the desire to have a positive impact on the community they serve.

Applicants must meet the following minimum qualifications:

Must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age by the application deadline

- o Be a U.S. citizen, be a high school graduate or graduate equivalency diploma (GED)
- o Have a Pennsylvania driver's license before appointment.
- o Meet the Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Commission standards for physical and mental fitness.
- Must not have a disqualifying criminal record.

The Township follows the Civil Service process. This includes a written and oral examination, a physical agility/ability test, medical and psychological exams, drug screen, and a thorough background investigation.

The Township offers an excellent salary and benefits package. Applicants who do <u>not</u> possess ACT 120 certification will begin at \$49,847.18 while they are in the police academy. Upon graduation, they receive \$79,751.19 as do applicants who already have Act 120 training. Police officers with experience elsewhere can receive a starting salary of up to \$89,722.78, depending on qualifications.

A preliminary application must be completed and returned to the Muhlenberg Police Department by April 5th, 2023 by 4:00 PM. There is NO CHARGE for taking the physical ability and written tests. The first part of the process will be a written test followed by a Physical Agility Test on SATURDAY, April 8th, 2023 and registration will begin at 0730 AM at the Muhlenberg Senior High-School cafeteria located on Sharp Ave, Reading, Pa. 19605. For both tests, applicants must produce proof of identification (Government issued photo ID required) (i.e. picture driver's license) at the testing sites, for admittance to the testing facilities.

Candidates will be notified of their test scores, when a candidate passes both tests, then a \$35 fee will need to be paid in check or money order, made payable to Muhlenberg Township, to continue in the process. Applications may be picked up at the Muhlenberg Township Police office, 210 George Street, Reading, PA 19605 during normal business hours on Monday through Friday from 8AM to 4PM starting April 10th, 2023, Applications can also be downloaded from the Township's website at: www.muhlenbergtwp.com.

Applications can be dropped off in person at the Police Department's office during normal business or sent via certified mail – return receipt requested.
