## HOME AWAY FROM HOME

All new students without an approved residency requirement exception on file will be assigned housing for the 2020-21 academic year.

### IT'S, AT MOST, A 3-STEP PROCESS:

1. Complete the residency exception -OR- complete My College Roomie Profile (**through June 12**).
  - My College Roomie Profile can be found at **Kutztown.mycollegeroomie.com**. Log-in credentials were sent to student emails.

2. Form roommate groups for room selection (**through June 12**).
  - All roommate matching is completed in My College Roomie Profile.
3. Select housing assignment for the 2020-21 academic year.

### BEFORE ATTENDING NSO:

- Your child should read 'Preparing for Kutztown' and complete all assignments before participating in orientation.
- An email confirming orientation registration will be sent to his/her KU email. If not received, let us know.

## FIRST GENERATION STUDENT

---

If you or your spouse do not have a four-year college degree, then your child is considered a first generation college student who may qualify for the TRIO Student Support Services Program.

TRIO levels the playing field so students get resources needed to transition with ease. Enroll in a three-credit course designed for success, receive a personal academic coach and a peer mentor, gain leadership and student employment opportunities, and more. Students may even qualify for early course registration!

## DISABILITY SUPPORT SERVICES

---
