In this talk, Dr. Kutch will highlight ways that faculty members can make undergraduate research and creativity (UGRC) more inclusive and methods for moving students toward UGRC beginning in the first semester. The talk will feature three main examples. First, she will describe how she builds principles of UGRC into her First Year Seminar classes. Second, she and an advanced student (Katie Steigerwalt), will discuss a different approach they have taken to research collaboration. Third, she will illustrate how the inaugural KU Inspires Event promotes an inclusive UGRC environment.

About the Speaker: Dr. Lynn M. Kutch is Professor of German in the Modern Language Studies Department. Her main research focus currently is comics studies, in particular as they relate to social justice. Since spring 2019, she has served as KU's Coordinator of Undergraduate Research and Creativity.
