### About the panelists:

**Dr. Lynn M Kutch** is professor in Modern Language Studies. In addition to German courses, she also teaches FYS and CMP 201. Her main research interests include detective fiction and comics studies. Dr. Kutch is also currently serving as Coordinator of Undergraduate Research and Creativity.

**Dr. Adrienne Oakley** is an associate Professor in Physical Sciences. She teaches introductory and advanced courses in marine science and geology to a broad audience, and her research focuses on deep ocean basins and coastal zones. Dr. Oakley's active research program at KU involves several undergraduates and is made possible through partnerships with the Chincoteague Bay Field Station, Chincoteague National Wildlife Refuge, and NASA's Wallops Flight Facility. Dr. Oakley served as the chair of the Academic Advisory Council for PASSHE's Chincoteague Bay Field Station of the Marine Science Consortium in Wallops Island, VA and coordinator for Kutztown's Marine Science Program for the last 5 years.

**Dr. Tony Wong** is an associate professor in Mathematics. Mathematical games and puzzles were what drew Tony Wong into mathematics in the first place. Prior to college, he competed in numerous mathematics competitions at the international level. With this background, Dr. Wong is passionate in providing training for students to participate in mathematics competitions. He also serves the community by organizing outreach activities for students in local school districts. In research, Dr. Wong actively engages students in his projects with publications on reputable journals.
