Degree Works (Student)


Overview

Degree Works is a tool that allows students and their advisors to track their progress towards a degree from Kutztown University.

Students and their advisors can use the tool to generate **Degree Audits**, which detail the course and credit requirements for the assigned degree and provide suggested courses for those that have not been met.

Degree Works can be accessed from the sidebar of your **Student Profile**.

Note that your advisor has additional resources in **Degree Works**, including a **What-If** audit that can help advise on changes to your academic plan, like adding a minor or changing majors.
