## 042000 UNIT MASONRY ASSEMBLIES

- 1. All mortar additives, where required, shall contain no more than 0.1% chloride ions and shall be certified as such by the Contractor.
- 2. Provide cavity walls for exterior masonry walls.
- 3. Face brick shall be red; color and texture to be approved by the University. University standard face brick is Glen-Gery 53DD unless otherwise approved.
- 4. Provide mortar color to match existing adjacent construction. Coordinate with the University Facilities Department and Projects Office.
- 5. Provide adequate through-wall flashing, with weep holes in masonry at 16" o.c.
- 6. Give attention to parapet design. Ensure proper waterproofing at back sides of parapets. Metal copings are preferred, rather than cast stone, brick, or concrete copings when design permits.
- 7. Indicate masonry expansion joints at proper spacing and locations.
- 8. Ground-face block is desirable in high-traffic areas.
