224000 PLUMBING FIXTURES AND EQUIPMENT

- 1. Toilets shall be floor mounted and be capable of functioning with a water consumption of 1.6 GPF or less. Flushometers for toilets must consume 1.6 GPF or less.
- 2. Ensure adequate access chases.
- 3. All urinals and flushometers shall be of a type that is ultra-low water consumption (1/8 gallon per flush) comparable to the Zurn EcoVantage (Z5798 Series).
- 4. No automatic slow shutoff type faucets.
- 5. NO self-closing valves.
- 6. Provide sump pumps in occupied basement areas.
- 7. Tempering valves for domestic hot water heaters shall be at the hot water heater.
- 8. Water diverters for electric water coolers shall be made of metal material.
- 9. Aerators shall create a restriction allowing a maximum flow rate of 1.0 GPM
- 10. Showers heads shall restrict flow to a maximum rate of 2.25 GPM.
- 11. Water coolers shall be equipped with bottle filling stations.
- 12. Toilets and urinals shall be equipped with battery operated flush valves. Lavatory faucets shall be manual.
