- 1. Provide aluminum ductwork for damp areas such as toilets and locker rooms.
- 2. Direct drives are preferred on fans instead of V-belts.
- 3. When V-belts are used provide 2 cogged, or 1 banded belt.
- 4. For laboratory exhaust, manifolded exhaust system is preferred instead of individual exhaust.
- 5. Exhaust fans for laboratories should be on emergency power.
- 6. On balancing dampers, provide standoff's and locking quadrants.
- 7. Provide protection of ductwork at job site. Temporarily seal ends.
- 8. Rapid entrainment types of diffusers are preferred. Avoid slot diffusers.
