270001 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS

- 1. Using University-specified components, a minimum of one emergency communications device shall be provided in each building. The location of the emergency communications device will be determined by the University's Environmental Health and Safety Specialist. Additional communications devices may be required because of design, or size and configuration of the building. The Environmental Health and Safety Specialist shall contact the Design Professional to coordinate the number of emergency communication devices and location (s) for the devices. Installation and connection of emergency communications devices to the campus telephone system shall be coordinated with the University's Telephone Services representative.
- 2. All emergency communications devices shall be provided with appropriate signage drawing attention to the device. The sign shall be double-faced graphic marker, 4" x 12" vertical mount, red background with white symbol and lettering. Symbol shall be a telephone and lettering shall indicate "Emergency Phone". The sign shall be mounted 72" AFF, to bottom of sign.
