## Psy 305 Practicum in Psychology

## Proposal (3 credit hours)

This is a supervised learning experience in an approved applied setting that may be on- or off campus. Psychology field settings are expected to include placements in human or animal service organizations. Psychology research settings are expected to include placements in academic or government institutions. Field and/or research experiences might include, but are not limited to, volunteering for a non-profit organization or government agency, observing at a church, school, or hospital, or working as a research assistant in a laboratory or other facility. This learning experience is not designed for activities related to Industrial/Organization or Clinical/Counseling services, which have existing internship courses for credit (See PSY 362 and PSY 363). Early in the semester prior to the psychology field or research experience, the student must work with a faculty supervisor to determine the expected work hours and to develop a proposal outlining the anticipated learning activities.

## PREREQUISITES:

- Minimum grade of C in Psy 11 General Psychology
- Minimum grade of C in Psy 200 Statistics for Behavioral Sciences
- Completion of 12 credits in Psychology
- QPA 2.5 or higher

Practicums are arranged a few weeks before advising and registration. The student is expected to volunteer at the site for a total of 136 hours (9 hours/ week) for 14 weeks during the Fall or Spring semester to earn 3 credits. A student may earn up to 6 credits. In addition, the student will complete required assignments with the psychology faculty supervisor listed below. The site supervisor is to provide feedback on the student's attendance and performance with the Faculty Supervisor.
