## Will I receive credit for military experience and coursework?

Yes! Submit your official military/DoD Joint Service Transcript (JST) or your Community College of Air Force (CCAF) transcript to the KU Registrar's Office to have your military training/experience evaluated for possible academic credit.

## What degrees does Kutztown University offer for veterans and service-members?

## Does Kutztown University offer military-specific orientation?

Yes! In addition to New Student Orientation, students who are using their own, or their parent's military benefits, are provided with a targeted online orientation after they pay their Advanced Registration Deposit (ARD).

## What is the deployment policy at Kutztown University?

Students who are deployed during the school year can receive an "M" or "military" on their grade transcript for classes they are unable to complete, and there is no academic penalty. Maximum flexibility is considered for financial obligations.
